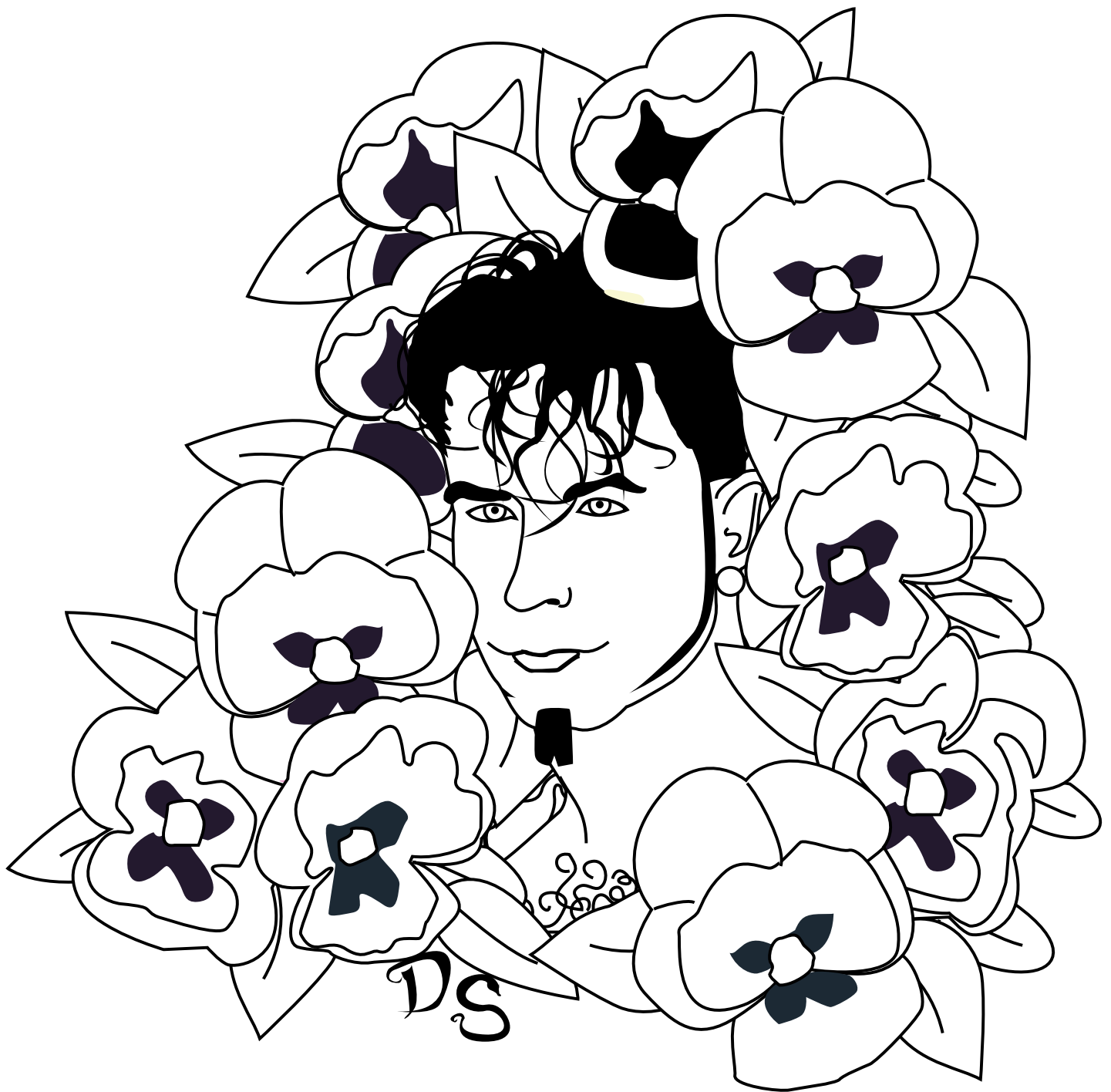

You will also find that we have included several graphics that are suitable for taking to work for breaks or lunchtime. How about putting some energy into the dragons' statement of "Down with George"?

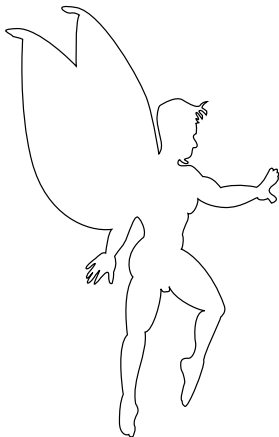
