

The chant “*Faggots in the Woods*” erupted spontaneously and with great force at our Thursday night ritual at the fire last year and continued through the rest of the Gathering. This chant expresses defiance at the culture that demeans us, the strength in our community, and the assertion that we fully belong here, in Nature, together. We were, and are re-claiming our connection to the earth and each other from centuries ago, when Christianity wiped out fairies and witches because they could not easily be controlled, often burning them with bundles of wood called “faggots.”

Using “*Faggots in the Woods*” as our title is our way of telling the universe that we are stepping into brave space. We will continue to put our shame and fear in the fire, to heal ourselves, and reclaim our power. We know that the word faggots is uncomfortable. We invite you to dance on that challenging edge.

Fags, sissies, cock suckers, butt fuckers, ass lickers, bold exhibitionists and shy LTR-seekers—all such expressions are welcome within this sacred safer space of the woods and meadows at Wolf Creek Radical Faerie Sanctuary.



Registration is Required to Attend this Gathering

It takes 10 minutes to register online. It is easy and it makes a huge difference to the success of the Gathering by helping create a strong container for the comfort and safety of all.

Registration will be capped. No more than 150 people will be on the Land on any given day. We strongly discourage coming to the Gathering for only the last two days. Anyone registering for **less than 3 days will be put on a waiting list** (unless it's for earlier in the week).

The suggested donation for the Gathering is \$40.00/day. All meals, hot showers, camaraderie, and magical experiences included! This gathering has a “no one turned away for lack of funds” (NOTAFLOF) policy. Please give as you are able and always give something. **Payment at time of registration is preferred.**

Accommodations are mostly camping. We do have some shared cabin space available to those with special needs. **Please indicate your need on the registration form** and we will do our best to accommodate you. Camper vans are welcome in the parking lot with limited power hook up.

All meals will be communally created and shared. There will be plenty of food for all dietary needs. **Please indicate your diet when registering.**




What to Bring

- An eagerness to participate
- Your vulnerable heart
- A talent/no talent show act to perform
- A workshop to offer
- Drag and dress up (*or dress down!*)
- Drums and musical instruments
- Magical & sacred items for rituals & altars
- Games to play
- Tent, sleeping bags, and comfortable sleeping pads
- Essential medications
- Condoms, lube, sex toys, and gear
- Creek safe soaps
- A few personal towels
- Items for the spa (*massage sheets, lotion/oil, fingernail polish, etc.*)
- Warm clothes and rain gear
- Flashlights and batteries
- Sunscreen, insect repellent, and sun hat
- Camping chairs and sitting blankets

What Not to Bring

- Dogs or any other pets
- Illegal drugs
- Candles, incense, or anything that is a fire danger
- Alcohol will be restricted to the parking lot and private campsites
(*And let's not get messy with it or any other drugs you may be ingesting!*)
- Nomenus drug policy: "Meth, coke, heroin, GHB, and rohypnol: Not on you, in you, or in your car."**
- Anyone violating this boundary will be required to leave the Land!



About Wolf Creek Radical Faerie Sanctuary & Nomenus

The Wolf Creek Sanctuary is located in the mountains of southern Oregon, about 4 miles off of Interstate 5 (and 25 miles north of Grants Pass). Hillsides forested with Douglas Fir, Madrone, Big Leaf Maple, and White Oak surround a lovely rolling meadow and the flowing waters of Wolf Creek. There are 80 acres of land to camp, play and explore along with the creek to dip into and solar hot showers to enjoy.

Founded in 1987, [Nomenus](#) is a nonprofit 501(c)3 religious organization (or “church”) whose mission is *“to create, preserve, and manage places of spiritual and cultural sanctuary for Radical Faeries and their friends to gather in harmony with nature for renewal, growth, and shared learning.”*

Nomenus serves by stewarding the Wolf Creek Sanctuary as a sacred space dedicated to queer liberation and spiritual growth, honoring its founding intention as a sanctuary for Radical Faerie culture and gay male spirituality. The organization has evolved to include all genders and non-genders.

Nomenus is an all-volunteer organization with an operating budget of \$50,000-\$75,000 per year, sustained by over a hundred members and by the several gatherings that Nomenus sponsors and hosts each year (including SGRF). We work together in a consensus-driven process to accomplish the care of the Sanctuary. Most of this work takes place in circles and committees. Becoming a member and participating in these is the primary way to get involved with Nomenus. That and (or) making a recurring financial contribution.
